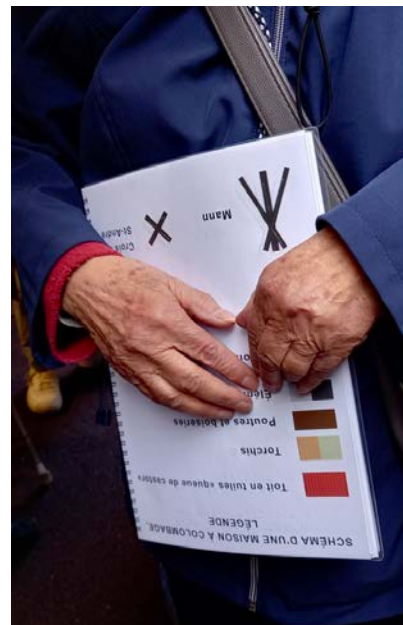

Do you prefer museums ? Visit 7 cultural places in the historic center.

The price of the guided tour does not include the entrance tickets for the museums and the Dominican Church. The entrance tickets are to be paid in addition by the customer on the day of the guided tour. For a comfortable visit, our groups are limited to 25 people per guide. (except for the Bartholdi Museum which is limited to 19 people).

Unterlinden Museum



This museum of fine arts covers 7000 years of history from prehistory to 20th century art. Formerly a 13th century convent, the Unterlinden Museum houses collections of ancient art including the restored Issenheim Altarpiece (1512-1516). Enlarged by the architects Herzog and de Meuron, an underground gallery gives access to the contemporary part where works by major artists such as Monet, Picasso, de Staël, Matthieu, Dubuffet, Dix, Soulages, and more recently Yan Pei Ming are exhibited. The old bathhouse houses temporary exhibitions.

Hansi Museum

Jean-Jacques Waltz, known as Hansi, delivers colorful testimonies of popular traditions and daily life in Alsatian villages in the 19th century. Naïve and incisive, the cartoonist presents an enchanting world for children and a caustic reading with tasty winks about the annexation of Alsace for adults. Exhibition of drawings, etchings and watercolors.

Excursions on the Alsace Wine Route



Located in the center of the wine road, nestled at the foot of the Vosges mountains, Colmar is the ideal starting point for an excursion on the 170 km long Alsace Wine Route from north to south. Stroll through its flowery fortified villages where you will admire the typical half-timbered houses in bright colors. Taste the 7 Alsatian grape varieties in one of the many famous cellars (to be chosen and booked by you). Tour with your own car, minibus or coach. Departure from Colmar and return to Colmar. Possibility to combine several visits.

Turckheim, a mediæval city

Hanged out in the heart of the Alsatian vineyards, Turckheim is a small mediæval city of character, charming for its heritage linked to the history of the vine. Former city of the Decapole, come to discover its 3 imposing doors, witnesses of the old fortifications. You will be seduced by its civil monuments of the XVIIth and XVIIIth centuries such as the Guardhouse, the Town Hall, half-timbered houses typical of the Alsatian architecture, the Ste-Anne church with a Romanesque bell tower.

Kaysersberg, birthplace of Albert Schweitzer

Former imperial city, Kaysersberg, surprises by the mediæval charm of its half-timbered houses, its church with a beautiful altarpiece, its fortified towers. Its fortified bridge of the XVIth century connects the lower town to the upper town dominated by the ruins of its castle. At the top, a splendid panorama on Kaysersberg and its vineyard.

Escape on the Alsace Wine Route



Eguisheim in the shape of a snail

Eguisheim is one of the most beautiful and typical villages of Alsace with its concentric alleys with half-timbered houses richly decorated with flowers. The city surrounded by hills covered with vineyards is overhung by the Three Castles which watch over it.



Ribeauvillé, Ribeaupierre's city

This medieval city, seat of the seigniory of the Ribeaupierre family, gave its name to the city. Famous for its three castles which that dominate it, its renowned wine heritage and its authentic half-timbered houses. Still today, it keeps a part of its ramparts including its defensive towers like the "Tour des Bouchers".

Riquewihr, the pearl of the vineyard

This medieval city located in the heart of the Alsatian vineyard is classified among the "Most Beautiful Villages of France". Known worldwide for its famous wines, called "Pearl of the Alsatian vineyard", it preserves today its authenticity behind its double enclosure thanks to its rich heritage from the 15th to the 18th centuries.



Mount Saint-Odile & Obernai

Obernai, the legendary birthplace of Saint Odile, is located 25 km southwest of Strasbourg. This fortified city was at its peak in the 16th century thanks to the craft industry and wine growing. Former city of the Decapolis, its belfry dominates the historical center rich of its half-timbered houses from the Middle Ages to the Renaissance. Find the emblems of the corporations on the facades.

Continue your visit by going to the Mont Saint-Odile, high place of pilgrimage dedicated to Saint Odile, patron saint of Alsacians. Splendid view over the Alsace plain to the Black Forest. Walking tour in the sanctuary: discovery of the tomb of Saint Odile, the chapels of the Tears and the Angels, the panoramic terrace and the miraculous spring (15 minutes walk).

Memory Sites & Crest Road

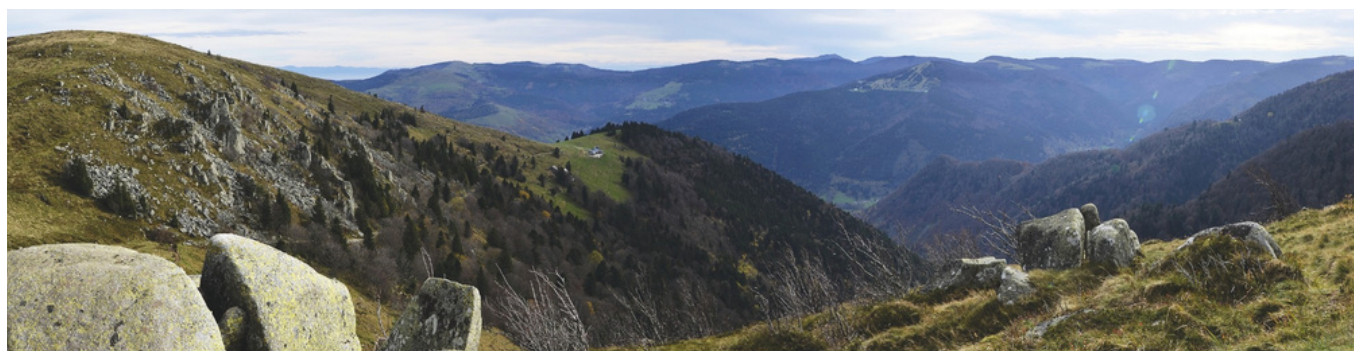
Formerly a strategic route, the Route des Crêtes offers breathtaking views of the summits of the Vosges mountains, the lakes, the Alsace plain and the Black Forest.

Discover and visit its high places of memory, witnesses of the fights of the First World War. Tour with your own coach. The Route des Crêtes is closed during the winter season by decision of the CEA (Collectivité Européenne d'Alsace).

Hartmannswillerkopf

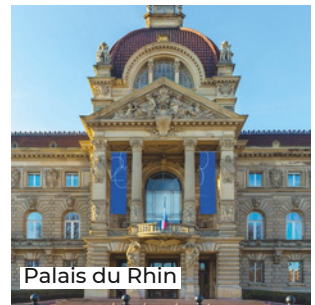
The first Franco-German memorial of the First World War, erected at an altitude of 956 meters, it was the stake of furious battles because of its strategic position. Also called the "Viel Armand" during the First World War, it presents a permanent exhibition, a national monument and a necropolis, battlefields. Today it symbolizes the Franco-German peace. Magnificent view of the Vosges mountains and the Alsace plain.



Linge Museum

This museum-memorial located at an altitude of 1000 meters explains the conditions of life and combat of soldiers in 1915 during the First World War. Visit outside the trenches, shelters and blockhouses which testify to the shelters left by the "Poilus" soldiers, from 1915 to 1918.

Full Day in Colmar & in Strasbourg

Arrival in Strasbourg, a European city classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Walking tour of the exceptional historic center of the "Grande île" and its prestigious Gothic cathedral. Discover the "Petite France" district, the "Vauban" dam and the covered bridges. Then panoramic tour with your own coach around the European Institutions and the "Neustadt New City" built under Kaiser Wilhelm II from 1872.

NUMBER OF PERSONS ON A TOUR :

25 persons maximum per guide for outside tours and in the museums
15 persons in Bartholdi Museum
The exact number of participants must be necessarily provided 7 days before the date of the arrival of the group (except for last minute visits).

MEETING POINT OF GUIDED TOURS :

Every guided tour leaves from Colmar Tourist Office, place Unterlinden.
If departure from the Bus carpark LACARRE, an extra hour will be charged.

It is recommended to the group leader to come
10 minutes before the tour starts.

DURATION OF GUIDED TOURS :

The length of the tour will be that mentioned on the confirmation. For a full day visit, lunch time is included in the price.
Guide service time imperatively begins at the time of meeting.

DESCRIPTION OF THE TOURS :

The visits are described in the Tourist Office's brochure. It is an indicative content.

With the client's agreement, the guide can adapt the tour depending on the group and/or special circumstances. On site the guide will not be obliged to accept changes of the content from the guided tour chosen as set out in the tour confirmation.

PAYMENT :

The total payment of the tour must be made at latest 15 days before the date of the guided tour (except for the last-minute guided tours)

- By credit card (bank fees must be paid by the client)
- By bank transfer (bank fees must be paid by the client)

In case of non-payment 15 days before the date of the guided tour, it will be automatically canceled (excepted for the last-minute guided tours).

CANCELLATION :

Any cancellation must be notified in writing to the Colmar Tourist Office.

1. Cancellation by the client :

In case of cancellation by the client within 4 to 7 days, Colmar Tourist Office in Colmar will retain 50 % of guided tour.

In case of cancellation by the client less than 4 days before the guided tour, 100 % of the guided tour fee will be kept and can't be refunded.
Colmar Tourist Office is not responsible for such cancellations due to weather conditions.

2. Cancellation by Colmar Tourist Office:

In case of cancellation by Colmar Tourist Office (absence of the guide due to illness or accident), the guided tour fee will be refunded to the client upon sending his bank account.

3. Modification of guided tour demanded by the client :

Administrative charges of 50 € will be requested to the client if the client asks for any modifications (date, time, theme of the guided tour, meeting point) on a signed tour confirmation.

BASED AND INCREASED PRICES :

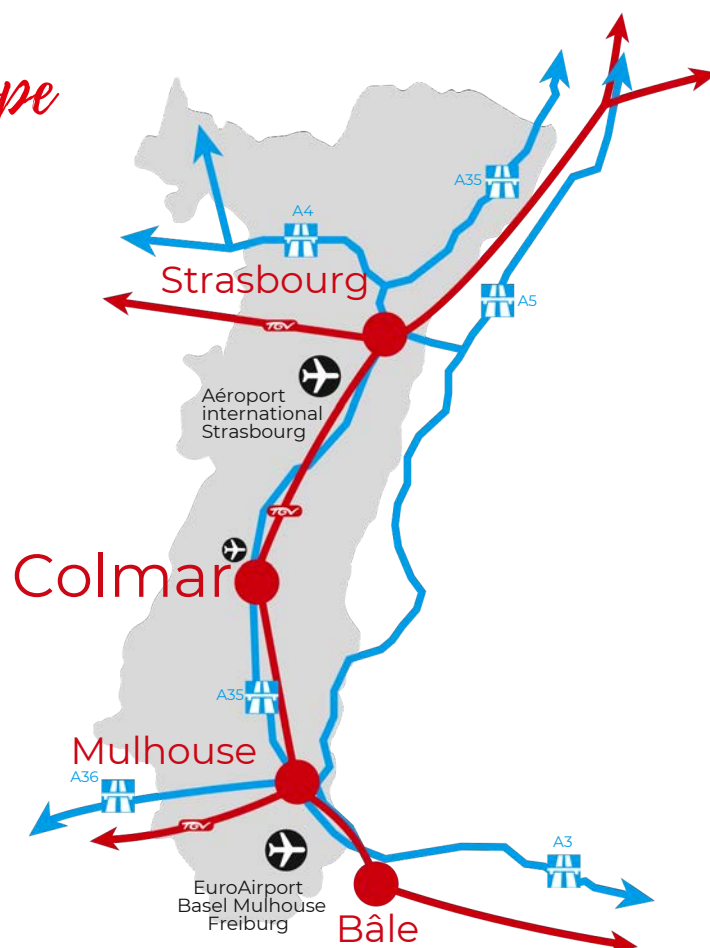
