

Guided Walking Tour of Colmar's Old Town: "Colmar, Capital of Alsace Wines" (duration 1,5 h)

Colmar, the capital of Alsace wines, reveals its rich historical heritage linked to the history of vineyards and wine in Alsace. Discover the city's most notable monuments, including the Maison des Têtes and its "statue du Tonnelier" (by Auguste Bartholdi), the Schwendi Fountain, and the Koifhus (Old Customs House)...

Visit of the Alsace Wine Museum with audio guide (entrance fee included)

The work of the vine, the harvest, the cellar, the winemaker and his winery, the Wine Route and its appellations will hold no secrets for you! Guided Tour of the Unterlinden Museum (entrance fee included, duration 1,5 h)

The museum, housed in a 13th-century Dominican religious sisters' convent and a 1906 former public baths building, is home to the Issenheim Altarpiece by the German Renaissance painter Matthias Grünewald and features a large collection of local and international artworks and manufactured artifacts from prehistorical to contemporary times

Located in the heart of Colmar, in Auguste Bartholdi's birthplace, this museum immerses you in the artist's intimate universe and his relationship with the world, through his preparatory works, sculptures, drawings, paintings, engravings, collections and objets d'art in over 12 rooms.

Entrance fee to the "Bibliothèque des Dominicains" - Dominicains Heritage Library & Museum (free visit to discover the museum)

A magnificent restoration has turned the former municipal library into an exceptional centre dedicated to books in all their forms. A brand new setting for a large collection: some 400,000 documents, including 1.200 manuscripts. Don't miss its cloister and its medieval garden.

Guided Tour of Ribeauvillé with the Touristic Train (duration 40 minutes)

Discover Ribeauvillé, a charming medieval village, the "Cité des Ménétriers", on a ride with the small tourist train. The route takes you through picturesque vineyards, offering breathtaking views of the Alsatian landscape, to the neighboring commune of Hunawihr. A tranquil journey through the heart of wine country for an unforgettable experience.

Guided Walking Tour of Riquewihr (duration 1,5 h)

Riquewihr is a medieval town in the heart of Alsace's vineyards, classified as one of the "Most Beautiful Villages in France". For centuries, this magnificent town has combined the quality of its architecture with that of its wines, hence its name "Pearl of the Alsace vineyards".

The moment you step over the threshold of the great door at Haut-Koenigsbourg Castle, you find yourself in a whole new world: the Middle Ages. It's the only medieval castle in Alsace that has been fully restored. A unique site that's not to be missed! Take the time to enjoy the breathtaking panoramic view over the Alsace plain, the Vosges Mountains, the Black Forest and even, on a clear day, the Alps...



Traditional Lunch in a restaurant of the city with "Tartes Flambées", excluding drinks

Guided Walking Tour of Sélestat's Old Town and the "Bibliothèque Humaniste" Humanist Library (entrance fee included, duration 2 h)

Sélestat, a city of Art & History with many buildings registered as Historical Monuments, such as the Romanesque church of Sainte-Foy (12th century), the Gothic church of Saint-Georges (13th-15th century) and the Humanist Library.

Explore the secrets of some truly exceptional books... The "Bibliothèque" Humaniste takes visitors on a fascinating journey, from medieval manuscripts to rare printed works 15th and 16th century, in a magnificent architectural setting created by Rudy Ricciotti.



The largest automobile museum in the world is there in Mulhouse! The Schlumpf collection is simply marvelous, including the Corvette, the Bugatti Royale and F1 cars. Take an interactive journey to the land of automobiles.

Those objects tell us with an outstanding precision the story of the “Poche de Colmar” battle. Those fights have allowed the liberation of Alsace which was annexed to the nazi Germany at this moment.




